

## **RMC FRIDAY FOCUS – Ferguson Center For The Arts**

Christopher Newport University's Ferguson Center is made up of three individual concert halls on the campus, and provides a fantastic venue for a large variety of events each year. Constructed in 2004, the Ferguson Center includes a 440-seat Music and Theater hall, a 200-seat Studio Theater, and a 1,700-seat Concert Hall. The Music and Theater hall opened in September of 2004 with a performance by Tony Bennett, and the larger Concert Hall opened the following year with Michael Crawford.

The Ferguson Center was initially intended only as a concert hall for the University, without an



academic component to the venue. Instead, the Center now also houses rehearsal halls, art and dance studios, and several of CNU's classrooms used by its music and theater departments.

Over the last decade, the Ferguson Center has hosted many great artists, performances, and events, and the University's students are very lucky to have access to such a great venue on their campus.
